She looks forward to working with existing and new committee members for the 2023 show and hopes that the show continues for many years to come.

Financial report - Colin Hodges

Colin reported that we had a good year and the show was well attended. Class takings and door entry takings were both well up.

There is a healthy bank balance - £2637.69. Colin has set a budget for next year with the aim of breaking even – if we make money then that is a bonus.

John reminded those present that the auctioning off extra special prizes that were donated for the tombola had been successful.

Colin proposed to the committee that a £500 donation be made to Snape Village Institute from the Snape and Well Village Show fund.

John suggested giving some towards the playing field fund for new goal posts. Colin suggested that we give to the institute this year and consider making a donation to the playing field fund next year. This was agreed by the committee.

Sarah Lowe thanked the committee on behalf of the Snape Institute Committee and said it would go towards the development fund.
