Financial Report – This year the committee decided that a one-off fundraiser during the year wasn't necessary. We have seen the best income for many years. The higher level of expenditure was due to the fact that we donated to the institute. Have a balance to date of £2460.41. including interest of £50 having swapped the account from HSBC to Skipton Building Society.

The Show takings for 2024 were up this year.

Colin proposed that of all the community causes we should be looking at giving more to Snape Institute as they don't receive anything from the show. Colin proposed that we should give them another £500 more at this point. Ann Donaldson seconded.
